

Gutter Glove Vs Raindrop

Gutter Glove

Grit and Granules: A great way to clean off your gutter guard (or any gutter guard for that matter), is with the use of **The Gutter Guard Brush**. It's designed to clean off any gutter guard without having to get on a ladder or roof. You just screw this special brush on the end of any standard extension pole, then from the ground, just reach up and brush it off. For more information and where to buy,

Pollen: We use a 30mesh (that is 30x30 holes/square inch) which is more effective than smaller hole sizes at keeping out pollen. The 30mesh that we use is the perfect size for managing rainwater into the gutter while keeping out all the leaves, pine needles, and even the roof grit. If pollen ever did clog an area of the micro-mesh, you can unclog it with a gutter cleaning brush like ours found [here](#).

Algae: Moss will grow on anything, except copper and zinc for the most part, so the answer is yes. Moss can grow on any gutter guard and roof. There are several types and brands of moss fungicide products available at nursery and hardware stores.

Trough: The installation video calls for the screen down at the front lip to be pushed down to create a trough to help stop the water from over running the gutter. This allows debris to gather.

Aluminum: Warehouse damage and transport damage can occur. If a forklift tine hits a box it will bend or dent the aluminum making it useless

Micro-screens: Are made of wire with creates friction, they are good at keeping everything out of the gutter eventually the top will be clogged keeping water out as well. And the homeowner must maintain yearly.

Comes in 5 and 6 inch versions making for 2 different skews at distribution

Raindrop

Raindrops apertures are wide enough to allow grit and granules to pass thru and the rain water flushes them down the downspout. Part of Raindrops self-cleaning.

Again, the apertures are wide enough to not clogged by pollen.

Polypropylene is algae resistant.

There are no "stop" barriers on Raindrop to block debris from being "pushed" over the edge by wind or rainwater.

Polypropylene is virtually indestructible. Forklift tines will only damage the box. A bundle of shingles thrown on Raindrop will not damage it.

Raindrop: Is smooth and rounded, no friction or friction points, requires little to no maintenance allowing the gutters to stay clear for years.

Raindrop comes in one size fitting both 5 and 6 inch gutters allowing for only 1 skew.
